The emphasis of these groups is on positive aspects of parenting, avoiding power struggles, and helping gifted children learn appropriate life skills while enhancing the parent/child relationship and parent self-esteem.

Thirty to forty parents are needed for parent discussion groups so that those being trained as facilitators can get some first-hand experience while the training is fresh and experts are still available for supervision and feedback. Come and meet other parents of gifted children interested in learning and sharing resources for providing for the social and emotional needs of their gifted children. Topics to be covered will include all aspects of raising gifted children **from preschool age through high school**. This group will follow the SENG Model of Gifted Parent Groups to facilitate sharing and discussion. ***This offer is open to the first 40 Seattle parents who register.***
